- Jurisdiction:** Held Under the rules of the ACU as laid down in the current handbook, the standing Grass Track regulations of the South Western Centre, and these supplementary regulations.
- Eligibility:** Open to all affiliated members of the ACU on proof when signing on.
- Entries:** **Closing on 13th March 2011** and must be on the entry form attached along with **SAE to return admission passes.**
Fee: £20 Youth, £30 Solo, £35 Sidecar (Cheques payable to Somerton & District MC & LCC).
- Signing On:** All competitors must sign on after scrutineering and before practice. The parent or guardian of any competitor under the age of 18 must also sign on alongside his/her rider. All competitors' licences will be requested to be shown to the Secretary of the Meeting at signing on.

- Non Starters: Anyone that enters this event and does not take part must give a satisfactory reason for the absence to the Secretary 48 hours prior to the event.
- Practice: Each competitor must complete the minimum of two laps. **Practice will begin at 10.30am and end at 11.30am prompt.**
- Machines: Must comply with ACU regulations and will be kept in the competition paddock at all times except when racing.
- From 1st MARCH 2011
- 500cc Solo and Sidecar machines** – must use a 2010 FIM Homologated silencer. The only exception are machines using engines not designed for Track Racing where an alternative silencer must be used and will be subject to sound control using the new FIM 2 metre Max method of testing.
- 250cc and 350cc Solo machines** – must use either the 2010 or 1995 FIM Homologated silencer. The only exception are machines using engines not designed for Track Racing where an alternative silencer must be used and will be subject to sound control using the current FIM sound control method.
- Pre 75 and Upright Solo machines** - must use either the 2010 or 1995 FIM Homologated silencer. The only exception are machines using engines not designed for Track Racing where an alternative silencer must be used and will be subject to sound control using the current FIM sound control method.
- 1000cc Sidecar machines** - will be subject to sound control using the new FIM 2 metre Max method of testing.
- 200cc and lower machines** – will be subject to sound control using the current ACU sound control method.
- Insurance: The insurance cover for this event will be Basic (limit of liability £10M) and Medical Malpractice insurance (limit of liability £5m) is included. There is NO Personal Accident Insurance for Competitors. Competitors are therefore strongly recommended to purchase such Cover which is available through the Locktons website (www.locktonmotorsport.com) or the ACU website (www.acu.org.uk).

Riding or Driving a Machine in the Pits Area is strictly forbidden.

The club will not tolerate any Verbal or Physical abuse to officials by competitors, parents, guardians, and pit crew.
